



GENERAL RULES OF THE SCHOOL

1. A student must carry his/her almanac to school everyday. It must have his/her recent photograph and identity, information duly filled and signed by him / her parents.
2. **Students must converse in English only.**
3. Students should arrive at school 10 minutes before the bell rings. No student is allowed to drive scooter /motor cycle without driving licence and helmet for safety. Late arrivals are liable to be sent back home.
4. Two wheelers / bicycles should be parked properly at allotted place only. School does not owe any responsibility in case of damage or theft. However security measures are provided.
5. Students should be neatly dressed. The school uniform has to be worn on every working day. On **Wednesday and Saturday** (except nursery) students should wear sports uniform housewise. Students who are sloppily dressed or not in prescribed uniform will be dealt severely.
6. Students should maintain personal hygiene and cleanliness.
7. Boys should get their haircut at regular intervals. Sikh boys must wear patka/turbans.
8. Girls should plait their hair if it is below shoulders. Short hair should be neatly cut and pinned.
9. Students should rise in the respect of Principal / Teachers and Visitors whenever they visit their class.
10. The school is not responsible for goods lost. No valuable articles like expensive watches, cell phones, cameras, jewellery, transistors etc. should be brought to school.
11. Students are strictly not allowed to bring mobile phone in school premises. If he/she is caught with mobile, will pay a fine of Rs. 500/- and the mobile will be handed over only to the parents after 15days. If he/she brings/caught with the mobile again then the mobile will be confiscated and the student will be suspended from the school.
12. Students are not to wear any jewellery to school (no chain, rings, bangles, bracelets.) Girls may wear one pair of small ear rings or studs.

13. Ambe Vidyalaya provides Education from Nursery to class XII. Therefore it is expected that the juniors to be treated with love and affection, while the juniors show all due respect to their seniors.
14. 80% attendance is compulsory for all students to appear in School / Board Examination.

Note : Class X & XII

- ❑ Students of class X & XII must attend school regularly specially on the days specified for GSEB formalities. Failing to comply, the school will not be responsible for filling the Board Exam forms online. Students will then have to go directly to GSEB office to get their Board Exam form approved to avail the admit card/hall ticket.
- ❑ Students to wear school uniform when they come in school to collect Hall Ticket / Result for their Board Exam.
- ❑ **80% Attendance** is compulsory to appear in Board Exam. The school will not be held responsible for any legal action taken by Gujarat Secondary Education Board for students having **less than 80% attendance** to appear in the forth coming **Board Exam**.
